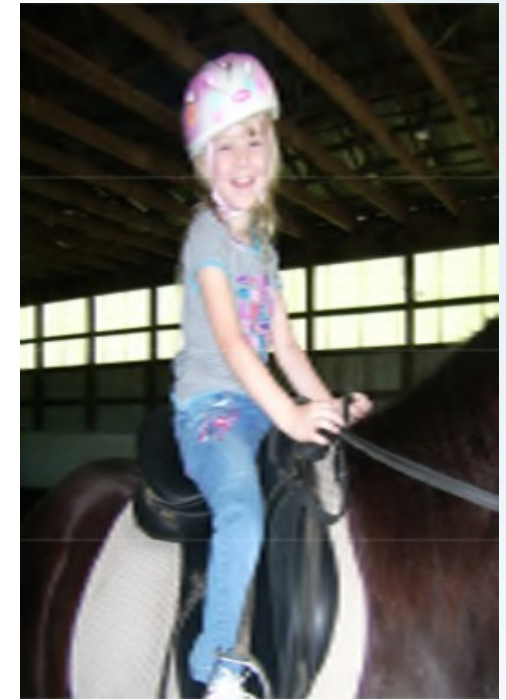
## Summer Camp Details

### Lunch

### What to Bring

While we do provide helmets, we encourage campers to bring their own riding or bicycle helmets. It is also a good idea to bring a change of clothes, sunscreen, a bathing suit, towel, and an extra pair of shoes in case they get wet.
